- 35 Eye screening camps conducted in 8 districts namely, Kasaragod, Kozhikode, Malappuram, Palakkad, Thrissur, Emakulam, Alappuzha and Kottayam
- Of the total screened 3891 were 50+
- 582 identified as having mature cataract
- 300 underwent cataract surgery at Little Flower Hospital & Research Centre, Angamaly
- 587 provided refraction services
- Awareness created on eye problems and need for timely intervention

(iv) Mrs. Shejina P, wife of Mr. Sreejith M, who scarified his life to nation on 08.07.2021 during the Service.

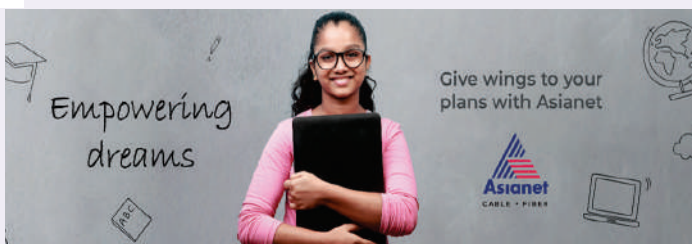


FREE LAPTOPS TO “PLUS TWO” STUDENTS
